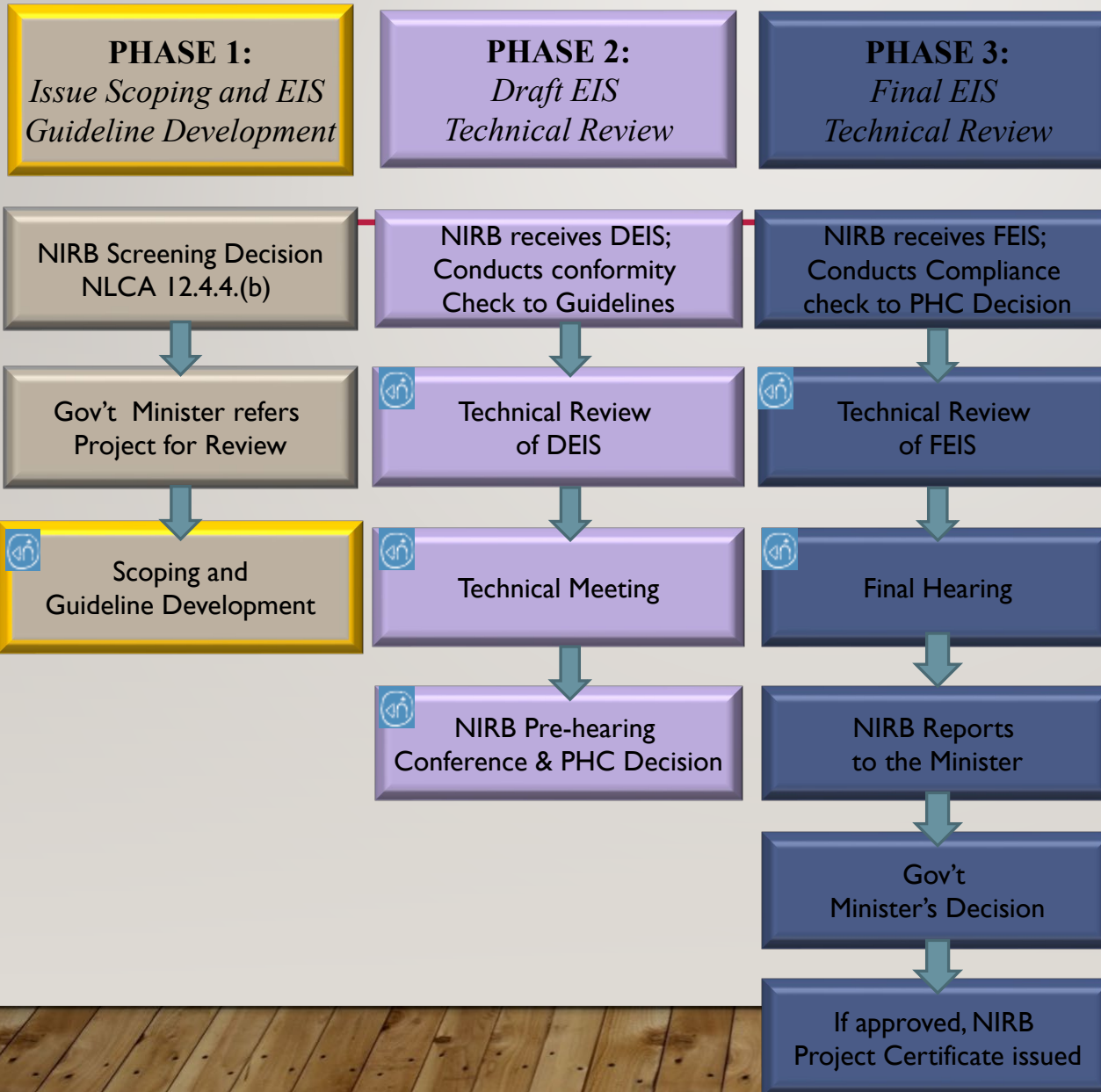


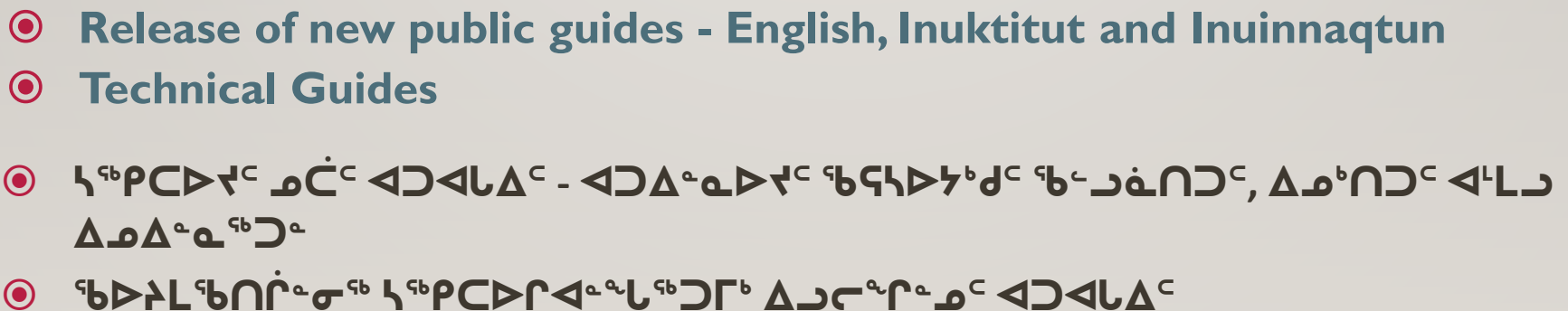
The Review Process

Phase 3: Update to Final Impact Statement and Board Decision



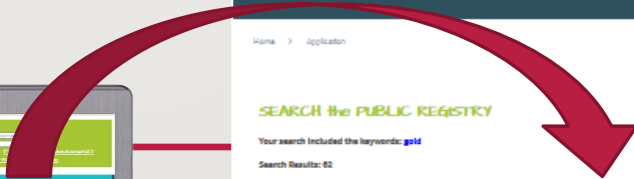


SCOPE

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CLOSING REMARKS

- Thanks to everyone for being here and their teams for the work on the scope and guidelines to date.
- Board will be reviewing the last changes
 - Scale of marine transport alternative in the scope and align section of guidelines appropriately
 - Raise points about use of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit in the draft as opposed to Inuit Knowledge directly referenced in Nunavut Agreement
 - Questions around direct use of IIBA in section 11.3.3 whether it is necessary
 - Whether inclusion of wolverine is required as a direct VEC or should be considered in the discussion of SARA listed species
 - NIRB staff will revisit the detail of content in Section 8 as it was generally proposed in response to parties' feedback stating that they liked how it was done for other projects. After being verified through the workshop that parties are interested in retaining this level of detail, NIRB staff will finish aligning the detail of this section to fit this proposal.
- Board previously committed to issuing the Scope and Final Guidelines to the Proponent and parties in September, 2023.
