Early in the morning, 05h34, this fuel line came off and diesel flowed onto the plywood floor of generator shack resulting in the generator stopping with a subsequent cut in camp power supply. The floor had been covered with several absorbent pads and hence soaked up the diesel outflow of about 45liters of diesel, estimated by weight of the absorbent pads. The contaminated absorbent pads were collected and put into a "Contaminated Pads" drum for containment and will be shipped out of camp to a licensed cleaning facility during Spring Mobe 2023.

Floor removed from just inside the door, clean (W).



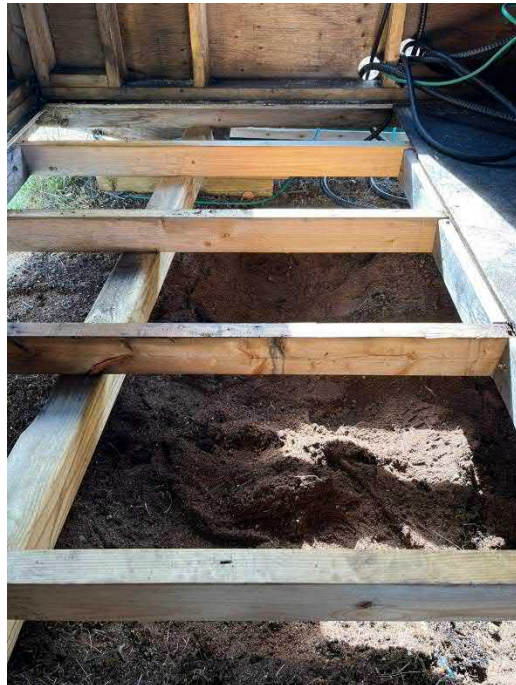
Floor removed from underneath the S gen, some old stained, contaminated sand.



Central part of floor removed, plenty of garbage discovered and removed. Contaminated sand removed as well.



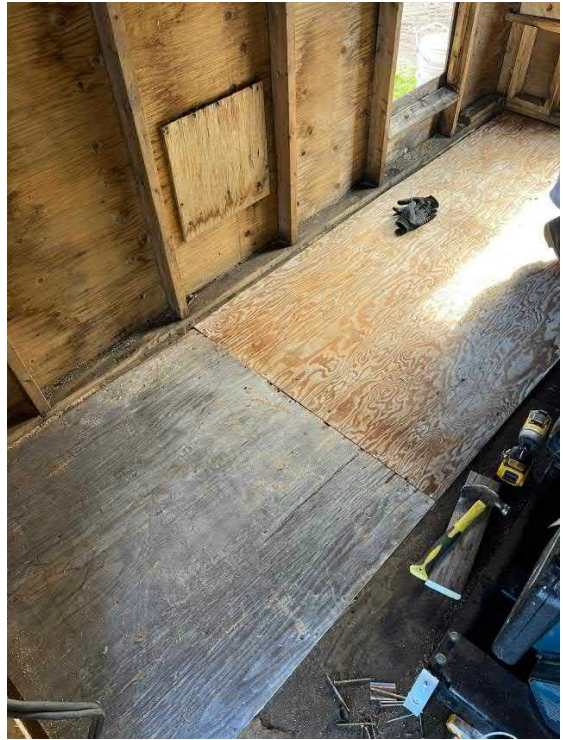
Floor removed from underneath the N gen, some old stained, contaminated sand.



The underside of floor underneath the S gen, diesel clearly has penetrated the sheet of plywood over the years.



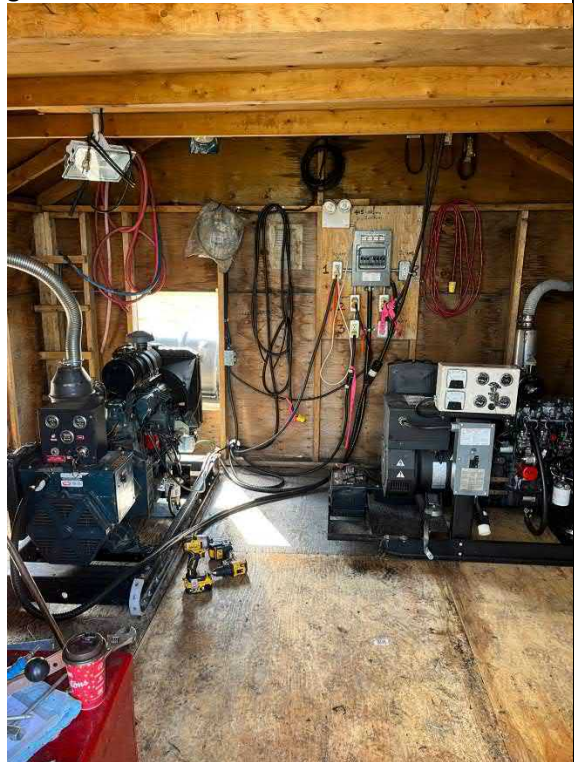
Two fresh panels of plywood installed.

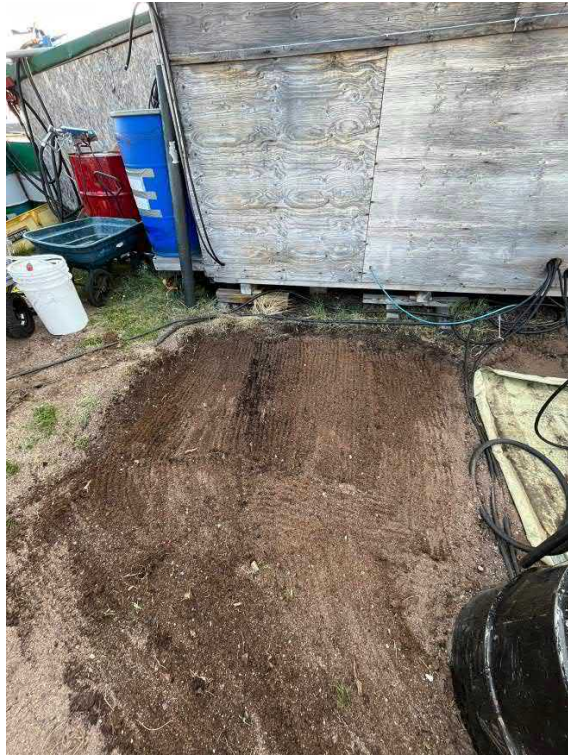
Floor replacement completed and looking great.

Diamond drill core rig suffered a breakdown in the head, stopping drill operations. The helper must have been filling equipment with the wobble pump, leaving the hose unattended and falling asleep and the P50 began gravity siphoning out of the fly tank. The helper could not be interviewed since he and the driller were removed from site on very short notice.

K Initially 1 absorbent sausage was deployed with numerous blue spill absorbent pads to contain the P50 spreading over the small, water filled depression, these absorbent pads have been switched out with fresh absorbent pads and 2 more absorbent sausages were added. Absorbent pad switch-out has occurred over the last 36 hours and will continue for 2 to 3 days. The contaminated absorbent pads are collected and put into a "Contaminated Pads" drum for containment and will be shipped out of camp to a licensed cleaning facility during Spring Mobe 2023.
