

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal, and a decision was issued on February 6, 2023, that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal have not been previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB). The project proposal requires screening by the NIRB because it does not belong to a class of exempt works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement.
