PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Bedrock Mapping at Uvauk Bay” project is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 110 kilometres (km) from Chesterfield Inlet. The Proponent plans to conduct bedrock mapping and collecting rock samples for laboratory analysis. The program is proposed to take place August 2024. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Hiring of a local wildlife monitor;
- Use of a temporary camp of seven tents;
- Use of field tools such as, hammers, notepads, cameras; and
- Use of a generator to power camp;
