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Hi Kelli,

Please see the below responses concerning the two outstanding questions for the Sealift improvement project:

1. **Temporary Camp** – is this something that would be considered as part of the proposed projects is if these are something that your company/GN would be responsible for permitted and setting up and managing or is this something that would be managed by the Contractor

The temporary camp would be managed by the contractor. The area for the camp has been identified on the NIRB plan in a location specified to EXP by Government of Nunavut staff. It is understood that this area is currently used by Pilitak staff for the construction of the school and lagoon projects.

2. **Quarries** –would there be any significant expansion to existing quarries that would need to be addressed by the NIRB? The GN and NIRB have an agreement that says that the establishment or significant expansion to existing quarries should be looked at by the NIRB. Therefore, if there is an expansion would that be a part of this project or would it be something that would be handled by another department or by the Hamlet.

No, there would be no significant expansion to the existing quarries. A recent granular materials resource study conducted by EXP in Taloyoak confirmed that the available quantities from each source are sufficient to meet the current project scope.
