The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. RENEWAL of marine-based tourism activities.
2. Associated NPC File No.: 149993 and 150352; Associated NIRB File No.: 23TA030
3. Location: Qikiqtani Region and Transboundary; [Port-of-call at Iqaluit, Lower Savage Islands, and Resolution Island; Transboundary, Saglek Fjord in Torngat Mountains National Park]

A complete description of the project proposal reviewed by the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) can be accessed online using the link below.

The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal and has determined that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The works and activities associated with this proposal were previously

reviewed by NPC on including marine-based tourism activities. In addition, the associated activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB File No. 23TA030).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the *Nunavut Agreement* do not apply.
