The proposed “Izok Corridor Exploration” project is located within the Kitikmeot region, approximately 150 kilometres (km) east and 210 km south of Kugluktuk. The Proponent intends to conduct. The Proponent intends to amend the scope of previously approved activities to conduct mineral exploration in newly acquired mineral claim areas. The program is proposed to take place from April 2025 to December 2028. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Conduct surface exploration drilling
- Conduct geotechnical, core or diamond drilling programs
- Use of camp
- Use of CAT dozer to construct air strip
- Use of helicopter and/or fixed wing aircraft to transport personnel and equipment
- Storage of fuel and chemical at camp site
