As you know, in our April 2, 2025 written submission, the Athabasca Denesuliné NéNé Land Corporation (ADNLC) requested that a scoping session for the Gray's Bay Port and Road Project be held in the Athabasca Region. We initially met with NIRB staff on May 21, 2025 to discuss a date that would work for this and determined late summer would be the most likely time available to work. Given that we have not had a scoping session yet, we will not be submitting our written comments on the project scoping until after we have had the session in our region and therefore will require an extension to the initial due date of July 16.

We look forward to continue working with your staff to determine a date that will work for all to host a scoping session in the Athabasca Denesuliné region and finding a date shortly after that to submit our written comments.
