Object: Agnico Eagle Meliadine Gold Mine – Submission of Waterline-Related Documents (Project Certificate No. 006)

Dear Mr. Morrison, Mr. Nayak,

Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) operates the Meliadine Gold Mine (the Mine) in accordance with Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) Project Certificate No. 006 and Nunavut Water Board (NWB) Type A Water Licence 2AM-MEL1631 (the Water Licence).

In 2022, Project Certificate No. 006 was amended (Amendment 002) to authorize significant modifications to the Meliadine Gold Mine Project, as proposed in the *Saline Effluent Discharge to Marine Environment Proposal*. These modifications included the construction of a 34 km Waterline to convey treated saline effluent from the Mine to Itivia Harbour, as well as the installation of a marine outfall and diffuser system via a Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) corridor.

As part of Amendment 002, several Terms and Conditions (T&Cs) were added or updated with respect to the construction, operation, and monitoring of the Waterline. In addition, Agnico Eagle made a number of formal Commitments during the Waterline permitting and review process, as documented in the *Agnico Eagle List of Commitments as of June 17, 2021, Waterline FEIS Addendum, Saline Effluent Discharge to Marine Environment*.

Agnico Eagle is pleased to submit the following documents in fulfillment of the below listed Terms and Conditions (T&Cs) and Commitments.
