The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) is continuing the assessment of the proposal by allowing parties to comment on the *modified* project proposal following the NIRB identifying that proposed project areas were added to the NIRB application and not covered by the previous conformity determination. On April 28, 2026, the Nunavut Planning Commission provided a positive conformity determination for the additional southern portion of the area indicated in the NIRB application.
