The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. **Primary Land Use:** Marine-based Tourism
2. **Project summary description:** The Students on Ice 2026 Youth Expedition will bring a large contingency of students, elders, scientists and experts on an educational cruise across 2 countries.

- Sailing on MV Ocean Nova from Nuuk onwards to Labrador, Iqaluit, Pangiqtuuq, Qikiqtarjuaq and returning to Greenland

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. NPC has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC, and the last conformity determination was issued on March 8, 2024. In addition, the works and activities listed above were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE No. 13AN014).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that the inclusion of Hantzschi Island activities does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the *Nunavut Agreement* do not apply.


By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
