This includes that the shipper preparing the dangerous goods shipment for air transportation must have International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) training for dangerous goods. The shipper must meet the requirements set out in Part 12 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, which includes the ICAO training requirements.
