WORKSHOP PRESENTATIONS & DISCUSSIONS

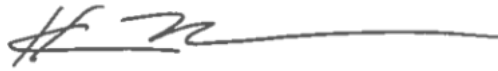
The NIRB will be providing presentations to summarize its monitoring of the project and is working with Baffinland to present its mitigation and monitoring related to marine activities of the project. Baffinland will be addressing the following information for Pond Inlet residents:

1. summarize and give background on activities completed to date, highlight project-related activities of ongoing shipping from Milne Inlet including results from its 2025 shipping season, and expectation for the upcoming 2026 shipping season;
2. Baffinland's coordination of project-specific monitoring with NIRB and other regulators, including how Baffinland has responded to recommendations resulting from the previous Marine Workshops, and
3. Highlight actions taken by Baffinland to address community concerns as well as recommendations made by NIRB and other regulators to limit project-specific impacts.

Regulators copied on this Notice are encouraged to support the meeting with at least one in-person representative with the expertise to inform the discussion between community members and regulators during the workshop, provide information and responses to the community members questions as they arise, and facilitate multi-department responses engaging online participants to provide full perspective to the community. Due to the potential for limitations on regulatory participation due to logistics constraints, the NIRB will provide online access to participants that register by **September 30, 2026**, by providing name, email, agency, and position.
