The proposed project includes water withdrawals from Airport Creek in Grise Fiord using a water intake. Works, such as the proposed water intake, in navigable waterways are subject to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act (CNWA) and in some cases may require an approval under the CNWA. Works in non-navigable waters are not subject to the CNWA.

Using Transport Canada's Navigation Protection Program Project Review Tool, the proponent has determined that Airport Creek is NOT navigable. As the water intake will not be installed in a navigable water, the project is not subject to the CNWA and does not require an approval from Transport Canada.
